INVITATION TO A BETTER LIFE

John 7:37-39 – On the last and greatest day of the Feast, Jesus stood and said in a loud voice, “If anyone is thirsty, let him come to me and drink. Whoever believes in me as the Scripture has said, streams of *living water* will flow from *within* him.” By this he meant the *Spirit*, whom those who believed in him were later to receive.

JESUS UNDERCOVER

John 14:16-18 – “And I will ask the Father and he will give you *another Counselor* to be with you forever – the *Spirit of truth*. The world cannot accept him because it neither sees him nor knows him. But you know him, for he lives with you and will be in you. I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you. Another Jesus with and in me!

SPIRIT RESUME

John 14:25-26 – “All this I have spoken while still with you. But *the Counselor*, the *Holy Spirit*, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you.
